Payment Options

1. Unlimited (EFT) Option

\$45 /month for the first child
\$30 /month for the second child
\$20 /month for each additional child
1 hour for infants
2 hours for 1-8 years old

2. Daily Drop-In Rate

\$8 per child for members
\$10 for non-members
one hour only

- All daily drop-ins and infants 2 weeks old through 12 months old are allowed 1 hour per day. Infants are limited to 2 infants per kids club staff member, at our discretion. For infants under 12 months, please give our kids club staff at least one hour notice before you bring your infant in. It will allow us time to make sure we are staffed accordingly.
- It is your responsibility to bring a diaper bag and supplies to ensure your child stays clean and happy. If your child is potty training, please bring them in a pull-up and pack extra in case we need it. There will be a \$2.00 charge to your account if we have to repeatedly provide diapers and wipes. We encourage you to bring any snacks your child might need. Due to allergy risks, we cannot provide any food for your child.
- Children over the age of 12 months through 8 years (at our discretion) are limited to 2 hours per day in the PEAK Kids Club.
 - Please do not bring your child in if they have any of these symptoms: fever, runny nose (that isn't clear), cough, diarrhea, vomiting, pink eye, or anything that could be contagious to the other children or staff. They must be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning to the kids club. We reserve the right to send a child home with their parent or guardian at any time to protect the well-being of our staff, the children, and other members.
 - Kids Club staff will notify you if your child appears sick or becomes sick during their stay with us, or if we experience any behavioral issues that cannot be resolved. Please respond promptly. If there are repeated and ongoing issues and incidents regarding either of these, your Kids Club membership may be reviewed to determine whether or not we can continue to provide kids club services for your child.
 - Kids Club unlimited memberships cannot be refunded or transferred to other children. One membership per child.
 - Please be prompt in picking up your child.
 - In the event of an evacuation, your child will be taken to the front parking lot. Upon exiting the building, please find your child there.
 - Your use of Peak Kids Club is at your own risk. You agree to assume liability for all risks, injuries, and/or damages to person or property which you or your child may endure while at a Peak location. By signing, you agree that you or anyone acting on behalf of you or your child will not bring any claims, demands, or cases of action for injuries or damages to person or property against Peak, its employees, owners, or management.
